



### Karina Davidson, PhD, MASC, FAHA

Dr. Karina Davidson is a clinical health psychologist and senior vice president of Research, dean of Academic Affairs, and head of the new Manhattan-based Center at the Feinstein Institute of Northwell Health. Her research focuses on innovations in personalized trials to manage chronic disease and patient

symptoms with emphasis on patient preferences and values. Dr. Davidson received her Master of Applied Science in industrial and organizational psychology and her PhD in clinical health psychology from the University of Waterloo in Canada. She has conducted National Institutes of Health-funded randomized, controlled trials on depression screening and treatments for healthy, hypertensive, and cardiac patients, and has had continuous federal grant support for her research for over 25 years. She has identified important psychosocial risk factors for incident and recurrent cardiac events and mortality, and the physiological and behavioral mechanisms by which that risk is conferred. Dr. Davidson is seen as an innovator in educational programming, and has won national and international awards for her research accomplishments, and university-wide awards for her teaching, mentoring and innovations in curriculum development.



### Tara Narula, MD

Dr. Tara Narula is a board certified cardiologist at Lenox Hill Hospital, an assistant professor of Cardiovascular Medicine at the Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/Northwell and a CBS News medical contributor. She contributes to various CBS News broadcasts and platforms including “CBS this Morning”,

“CBS Evening News”, “CBSN” and “CBS Sunday Morning”. She is also a frequent contributor to *O, The Oprah Magazine*. Dr. Narula joined Lenox Hill Heart & Vascular Institute of New York in 2010 and provides outpatient consultative care. She is board certified in nuclear cardiology, echocardiography and internal medicine. Dr. Narula obtained her medical degree at the University of Southern California’s Keck School of Medicine and completed her residency in internal medicine at Harvard University/Brigham and Women’s Hospital and her fellowship training in cardiology at New York Presbyterian-Weill Cornell Medical Center. Dr. Narula is currently a fellow of the American College of Cardiology (FACC). She serves as a member of the NYC Go Red for Women Committee and is a national spokesperson for the American Heart Association. She is a recipient of the Super Doctors Award for NYC 2014-2018.
